

# Cytology and Surgical Pathology Containers

## Liquid-based PAP (GYN)

Use either brush/spatula or broom-like device to collect specimen. Follow directions provided with supplies. In addition to PAP testing, the following tests can be performed from the same vial:

- Chlamydia
- Gonococcus (GC)
- Human Papilloma Virus (HPV)



Specimen Container Code **LQ**

## Non-GYN PAP

Cytology preservative for non-GYN specimens such as urine, thyroid aspirates and other fluids. Equal volume of fluid and preservative should be maintained.



Specimen Container Code **NGYN**

## Conventional PAP collection kit

Includes slide, cervical brush, spatula, and cotton tip applicator. Specimens should be preserved with spray fixative immediately after collection



Specimen Container Code **CPAP**

## Formalin containers

10% buffered formalin in either 15 ml or 60 ml size. Used to preserve tissue for histologic exam (surgical pathology). Hollandes (green) fixative is no longer required for gastrointestinal biopsies.
